- 2 Offset the remaining low unavoidable carbon emissions, resulting in paper made 100% carbon neutral.



Sappi North America and Domtar are industry leaders in environmental stewardship and responsibility.

Their papers are manufactured in North America, contain responsibly sourced fibre with various certifications (FSC, SFI/PEFC) and have a significantly lower carbon footprint compared to industry average - even 100% recycled paper.



Our association with Carbonzero allows you to secure high quality Canadian based serialized, quantified, and third-party verified carbon offsets to help neutralize the unavoidable emissions from your paper. Together we are pleased to offer an updated 100% carbon neutral program.

Ariva's Reduced to Zero; Carbon Neutral Program

When you participate in program, we apply credits to fully offset the low greenhouse gas emissions¹ from our papers, resulting in 100% carbon neutral paper at a very affordable cost.

Ariva does this by partnering with Carbonzero, a well-recognized Canadian carbon management organization, to carefully select and support initiatives that are (a) local to Ontario or Quebec, (b) that pertain to forestry, habitat maintenance, and/or the paper industry. Ariva has previously supported Ontario Biodiversity Afforestation Project (OBAP) and Southern Quebec Afforestation Project (SQAP), two initiatives that re-established forest species on land that would have otherwise been abandoned or used for agricultural purposes.

PREVIOUS Between calendar years 2020 - 2022, our customers neutralized 4,550 tonnes of carbon from the atmosphere by participating in our program. This is equivalent to carbon sequestered by 75,235 tree seedlings grown for 10 years.

CURRENT Currently, Ariva supports Niagara Escarpment Forest Carbon Project (NEFCP). This project has mitigated 75,000 tonnes of carbon in the atmosphere as of 2021 and is projected to continue into the next several years.

NEFCP promotes forest cover and ecosystem function, limiting the negative impacts of local dynamics. Tree growth in these areas and efforts to preserve in-situ rare species such as the Pileated Woodpecker, Painted Turtle, Great Grey Owl and geological features reduce carbon levels and improve biodiversity.

Carbonzero has worked with various companies in the paper industry and Ariva distinguishes itself through its unwavering commitment to sustainability and its exceptional dedication to assisting customers in reducing their carbon footprint. It's an absolute delight to join forces with them and supply high-quality, carbon offsets that make a tangible impact.

The Carbonzero Registry and offset portfolio is regularly audited, ensuring every carbon offset purchased receives a unique serial number and is retired exclusively preventing offsets from being re-issued at a later date.



Registries are well established in the market and have a proven track record of accurately tracking and verifying carbon offsets compared to newer methods such as blockchain. This can help to build trust with customers and ensure that their offsetting efforts are making a real impact in the fight against climate change.

Sappi North America's sphere of influence and impact on the environment extend beyond their mills' gates – from material acquisition through to manufacturing, shipping, use and disposal of their products.

Sappi North America has one of the lowest carbon footprints in the industry. Over 80% of their energy is generated from renewable or alternative fuels and 100% of their wood chips and purchased pulp are third-party verified as deriving from controlled and noncontroversial sources.

Sappi is committed to environmental stewardship, continuously devoting focus to and reaching its environmental goals. Since 2019, Sappi's scope 1 and 2 emissions have declined by 12.7% and are targeted to decline another 30% by 2030.
